### **REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS for: South System Watermaster/Operations Manager**

The District seeks an individual (or a special district or private company with appropriate employees) to provide watermaster and operations management services for the South System during the operating season of approximately April through November.

A qualified applicant must be able to:

- Communicate effectively with District board members, staff and landowners/customers taking water.
- Operate the SCADA-equipped, VFD, pump station, trouble-shoot pipeline problems, and coordinate water deliveries efficiently with minimal supervision.
- Manage data on diversions and deliveries in Excel format.
- Provide your own transportation, computer and tools.

North San Joaquin Water Conservation District (District) owns and operates five surface water delivery systems for irrigation and groundwater recharge. One of these systems, known as the "South System," includes a SCADA-equipped, VFD, pump station on the Mokelumne River, seven miles of concrete pipe, and associated distribution boxes, valves, meters and other facilities. The South System facilities are generally located east of Lodi, south of the Mokelumne River, north of Eight Mile Road and west of Bear Creek/Highway 88.
